San Rafael.

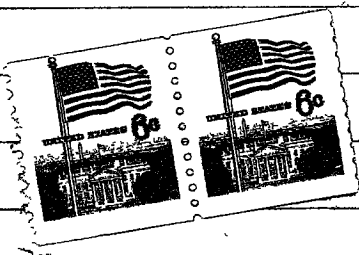
Well my beloved I will see

It has been raining so much that people aren't working, there is work but the weather doesn't let them work.

Did I tell you we have a Xmas tree, Richard Ybarra who works in El Mercado bought

We had a short meeting today at 1:30, they asked for volunteers to help do posting in the Membership Dept.
