FARM TORKERS PROTEST IMMIGRATION ENCORCEMENT LAXITY AT SUPREME COURT JUSTICE SPEECH

Supreme Court Justice Tom Clark's Town Hall speech at the Ambassador hotel was the site for a non-violent demonstration by the Delano rarm Workers this evening.

Justice Clark was to give a speech commemorating Law Day throughout the nation. The Farm Torkers decided to celebrate what they called their first 'when-Will-You-Enforce-The-Law Day' as a protest of what they cited as a alkity of enforcement of the nation's immigration !cus.

rony mendez, spokesmen for the rarm Workers Union, pointed out that large numbers of aliens from Mexico are presntly breaking the law by working on the Giumerra grape farms during an authentic lapor dispute.

These green c.rd bearing strike breakers are making it hard on American citizens by ignorantly acceptin slave wages given them by the Giumerra maragement while unionzed farm workers are making a living wage, said hendez.


Last year our grape boycott cost Giumarra over a million dollars and this year we will force management to the negotiating table, but first the rederal Government must enforce its laws equally.



The Deleno Larm Torkers, known officially as the United rarm Torkers Organizing Committee, and Cito, have been organizing mexican-factional and Philippino farm workers in Colifornia's San Jeachin V (ley since 1965.

Thus for the leader of the union, Cesar Chavez, has streeded non-violence in the campaign. To symbolize that stress, Chavez recently completed a 25 day fast. Thousands flocked to the closing deremony including benator hopert Kennedy, who later asked Chavez to join his California Presidential delegation.

The union has protested the laxity in immigration law enforcement before. Their protests involved closing the-U. A Mexican border at nio Grande City, Pexas.
